(ii) a merchant bank approved as a financial institution under the Monetary Authority of Singapore Act 1970, Chapter 186 of Singapore;

(iv) a company or co-operative society that is licensed under the Insurance Act 1966, Chapter 142 of Singapore to carry on insurance business as an insurer;
